Mandatory Organics Recycling Requirements - Let Us Help!

Effective January 2017, the State's Mandatory Organic Waste Recycling law (AB 1826) required businesses generating more than four cubic yards of organics (food waste and/or green waste) per week and multifamily residential properties with five dwelling units or more that generate four cubic yards of green waste per week, must arrange organics recycling services. Burrtec offers a food waste and green waste program that assists in complying with the law. The law phases in the requirements on businesses and multifamily residential dwellings over time, based on the following dates by 2019. Additionally, the state law contains a trigger that will increase the scope of affected businesses, if waste reduction targets are not met. Please see the schedule below:



Year	Cubic Yards Generated Weekly
2017	4 Cubic Yards (organic waste)
2019	4 Cubic Yards (commercial solid waste, regardless of amount of organic waste)
2020	2 Cubic Yards (commercial solid waste, if state does not meet goal)

The State requirements specify that applicable business waste generators do the following:

- Separate organic waste from other waste and participate in a waste recycling service that includes collection and recycling of organic waste.
- Recycle their organic waste on site, or self-haul their organic waste off-site for recycling.
- Subscribe to an organic waste recycling service that may include mixed waste processing that specifically recycles organic waste.

Mandatory Commercial Recycling requires businesses and public entities, generating four (4) cubic yards of trash or more and multi-family residential dwellings with five or more units, to establish and maintain recycling service.

Keep Your Recycling and Community Clean! - Updated Notice of Contaminants

Burrtec is working in partnership with your community to raise awareness of the importance of recycling, increase recycling participation and eliminate contamination from recycling and organics collection containers. This initiative is pertinent to the joint efforts of your community and Burrtec's continued recycling success as the state of California mandates become more critical.

Contaminated containers will be taped shut with a reminder to call our office should contaminants be found. The Notice of Contaminants Tape serves as a courtesy notice and reminder to remove contamination and contact our office. Notify our office once contaminants have been removed, your container will be serviced on your next service date.

Whether it's called dumpster diving or scavenging, it is the unauthorized removal of solid waste materials. Removal of materials from a bin may increase the cost of collection services. Materials placed in a recycling bin have a value that is used to offset collection and processing costs. When a scavenger breaks the law and removes those materials they are also removing any value associated with the recycling program, which ultimately affects costs. If you see a scavenger, do not approach them! Report illegal activity to local law enforcement. Also, please help us help you. Do not give permission to scavengers to take recyclables.
