Shred Event Details:

Please bring proof of residency such as driver's license or identification.

What to bring:

- Residents may bring up to 4 boxes (banker box size, 12" x 10" x 16") or 4 bags no larger than 15-gallons per person.
- Please only bring paper that should be shredded (most junk mail does not need to be shredded). Magazines, phone books, catalogs, etc. will not be accepted.
- Walk ups are not allowed. For your safety and to ensure everyone is treated fairly, please drive through the line and do not get out of your car. Staff will unload your materials and take them to the onsite shredder.

Two Events in One Day!

Compost Giveaway Details:

- Available to residents, at no additional charge, while supplies last!
- This is a self serve event so please bring sturdy bags, pails, containers, gloves and a shovel to take and load your compost. First come, first serve.

Benefits of Compost:

- Helps retain moisture to reduce watering
- Controls erosion
- Suppresses weed growth
- Provides beneficial nutrients to improve soil

Green Waste Drop-Off Also Available!

Acceptable Items:

✓ Branches and cuttings

✓ Flowers

✓ Leaves

✓ Grass

✓ Palm fronds

✓ Rose bush trimmings



Trimmings cannot exceed 3" in diameter

Non-Acceptable Items:

✗ Dirt

✗ Rocks

✗ Boulders

✗ Large Stumps

✗ Cactus

✗ Painted or treated wood

✗ Green waste in bags

✗ Household Hazardous Waste

✗ Concrete

Green Waste must be removed from bags or
other containers

Senate Bill 1383

The California Senate passed a bill requiring a 75% reduction in organic waste disposal. All residences are required to participate in this program to recycle organic waste and food waste.

Organic Waste that decomposes in a landfill releases a significant amount of greenhouse gas emissions that contribute to public health and safety concerns such as asthma, global climate change, extreme weather, and natural disasters. By composting organic waste, instead of sending it to landfills, we can close the loop on sustainability while creating a nutrient-rich soil amendment that's ready for use in farms and gardens.

Tips to Prevent Food Waste

- Plan ahead: Before you go to the grocery store or order out check the fridge and pantry for anything that needs to be cooked or that you already have and do not need to purchase.
- Serve smart: Aim to cook and serve the right portions for the number of people you are feeding.
- Store food wisely: Different foods require different conditions.
- Check your fridge often: Keep track of what you have and what needs to be used. Eat or freeze items before you need to throw them away.
- Use your freezer: Your freezer can help save your food and time.

60-Gallon Organic Barrels Available

Burrtec offers 60-gallon organics barrels for larger capacity and extra convenience for an additional monthly fee. The larger barrel helps contain excess material and reduces contamination. Personal barrels should not be used for excess green waste material. Please remember not to put trash in your recycling barrel. Please refer to the list of acceptable recycling items below. Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Disposal

Town of Apple Valley residents can drop off their Household Hazardous Waste at the following location:

Saturdays 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.



The following can be disposed of:

- Antifreeze • Batteries • Fertilizers • Household Cleaners • Medications • Needles in sharps containers
- Paints • Pesticides & Herbicides • Pool Chemicals • Propane Tanks • Used Motor Oil

Limit is 15 gallons or 125 lbs per visit in containers no larger than 5 gallons. These services are for residential use only. If you have any questions, please contact the Apple Valley Solid Waste Division at (760) 240-7569.
