What is organic waste?

Organic waste is any material that is biodegradable and comes from either a plant or an animal.

Examples of organic waste include the following material types:

- Food waste
- Food scraps
- Non-edible food
- Food soiled paper
- Non-hazardous wood waste
- Green waste (known as landscape or pruning waste)

Sustainability Update

The 2022 Food Waste Recycling Program and You!

California passed Senate Bill (SB) 1383 to improve air quality and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. CalRecycle reports that landfilled organic waste (including food waste) decomposes in landfills and generates greenhouse gas contributing to global climate change. Starting in 2022, all California residents will be required to participate in a Food Waste Recycling Program in order to comply with SB 1383.

SB 1383 requires a 75% reduction in organic waste disposal statewide by 2025.



SCAN TO LEARN MORE

All residences and commercial businesses will be required to participate in this program to recycle organic waste, including food waste.

Stay tuned for more information about when these new programs will start in your neighborhood. Town of Apple Valley residents will receive more information in the 3rd quarter of 2022.

- **Shred Fest** - Protect your identity. Shred your personal documents for free. Bring up to 4 banker boxes (12" x 10" x 16") of confidential documents to shred for FREE! PLEASE NOTE: Shredding ends at 12:00 p.m. or when the shred truck is full, whichever occurs first.



- **Mulch Giveaway** - There will be FREE mulch at the MRF during the Shred Fest event. This is a load your own mulch giveaway. Bring your shovels and bags or containers. The giveaway is for residents only- no businesses or commercial vehicles. Mulch limit is up to 50 gallons.
