Wildlife Deterrent Trash Barrels Available

Burrtec offers wildlife deterrent trash barrels to Bradbury residents for an additional monthly charge. Burrtec requires a three-month trial period for all issued barrels. The barrel has been constructed with a reinforced latching device that will prevent trash from spilling out of the barrel if tipped over by wildlife. These barrels will not entirely prevent a determined bear from prying open the barrel if the contents prove worth the effort.

Temporary Containers for Special Clean-Ups Available

Burrtec offers large and small containers for residential clean-ups and special projects. Containers are available for seven-day rentals and include delivery and removal. All unwanted materials can be placed directly into the container with the exception of hazardous waste, tires or large amounts of dirt, rock, concrete or asphalt. Collection Day Reminder

On collection day, please place your containers in the street, at the curb, or near the corner of your driveway. Barrels should have the handles facing towards your home. Barrels should be placed 1 foot apart from each other. The barrels need to be placed at least three feet away from any obstruction such as a fence, mailbox, or vehicle.

All barrels must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your service day.



Horse Manure Disposal

Manure must be hauled away weekly or fully composted in proper containers. Burrtec offers residents of Bradbury manure recycling pickup services. Call Burrtec Customer Service for more information.

Reminder: Green waste bins are for green waste only. Do not mix manure into those containers.

Proper Disposal of Household Hazardous Waste

Many households generate hazardous waste that is dangerous or illegal to dispose of in the trash and can also be harmful to the environment. Here is a list of the following items that are considered hazardous waste and should be disposed at a HHW location:

- Batteries or car batteries
- Cleaners
- CRTs, old TVs, misc. electronics
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Mercury thermometers or thermostats
- Motor oil, oil filters, brake fluid
- Paint, paint thinner, turpentine
- Pesticides or herbicides
- Pool chemicals
- Unwanted or expired prescriptions
- Used antifreeze
- Used needles or sharps
(In a Sharps container or sturdy box labeled "SHARPS")
