# What is organic waste?

Organic waste is any material that is biodegradable and comes from either a plant or an animal.

Examples of organic waste include the following material types:

- Food waste
- Food scraps
- Non-edible food
- Food soiled paper
- Non-hazardous wood waste
- · Green waste (known as landscape or pruning waste)

\*Please note: Green waste can be taken to the drop-off location provided by the CSD.

# Help reduce food waste in my community!

We are now all required to handle food waste differently. California Senate Bill 1383 mandates that we decrease the amount of food waste that goes to the landfill.

#### How does this affect me?

The District has been granted the opportunity to try a pilot voluntary food waste drop-off program. Residents can separate their food waste from their regular trash and dispose of it at the community drop-off location into a bin like the one in the picture below.



In an effort to keep your costs down, this voluntary pilot program has been established. If the program does not produce the tonnage diversion the State is looking for then all residents will receive a third trash can at your house to put food waste in. This will increase your bill by a minimum of \$7 per month.



#### Do I need a bag?

Yes, you will need to put the food in a bag before you drop it in the bin. Please do not throw unbagged food in the bin.



For the convenience of our residents the food waste drop off is available 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

#### Where do I bring my food waste?

A food waste bin is located at the north end of the parking lot at the Community Center - 26540 Vista Rd. For more information, please visit: https://calrecycle.ca.gov/ organics/slcp/ or contact the Helendale CSD office at 760-951-0006 x224

Please do not place trash, styrofoam, liquids, glass, plastic, metal, diapers, pet waste, electronic waste, batteries, and hazardous waste into this bin.
