#### **Shred Event Details:**

Please bring proof of residency such as driver's license or identification.

Free confidential on-site document shredding. (Yucaipa residents ONLY) \*shred event ends at 12:00 p.m. or when truck is full.

#### What to bring:

- Residents may bring up to 4 boxes (banker box size, 12" x 10" x 16") or 4 bags no larger than 15-gallons per person.
- Please only bring paper that should be shredded (most junk mail does not need to be shredded). Magazines, phone books, catalogs, etc. will not be accepted.
- Walk ups are not allowed. For your safety and to ensure everyone is treated fairly, please drive through the line and do not get out of your car. Staff will unload your materials and take them to the onsite shredder.
- There is no cost to residents for this service.

### **Collection Day Reminder**

On collection day, please place your containers in the street, at the curb, or near the corner of your driveway. The containers handles should be facing your home. Barrels should be placed 1 foot apart from each other. The containers need to be placed at least 3 feet away from any obstruction such as a fence, mailbox, or vehicle.

All barrels must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your service day.



### Electronic Waste (E-waste)

Electronic waste may contain potentially toxic substances such as lead, copper, and other heavy metals. This is why they must be disposed of properly! Electronic waste, or e-waste, may include computers, monitors and televisions. Residents may place e-waste items out with their bulky items for pickup. Please do not place e-waste in any of the barrels. Please Contact our Customer Service Department for more information.

### State Required Contamination Monitoring of Recyclables

California state law SB 1383 requires jurisdictions to monitor trash, recycling, and organics barrels to minimize contamination. Please review the "What Goes Where" guide for reminders of acceptable items in each barrel. Recycling loads containing unacceptable items may be rejected for processing and sent to the landfill, which eliminates the benefits that are produced from the recycling program. High contamination of your recyclables could result in increased processing costs which may impact your trash and recyclables collection fees. ### SHARPS COLLECTION PROGRAM

#### Yucaipa Residents Only

#### What are home-generated SHARPS?

"Home-generated SHARPS waste" means hypodermic needles, intravenous needles, lancets, and other devices that are used to penetrate the skin for the delivery of medications derived from a household.

State law prohibits residents from disposing of home-generated SHARPS waste in the trash. Sanitation workers or anyone who handles trash can be injured from needles or devices that penetrate the skin.

#### How is a SHARPS container obtained?

Residents can pick up a free SHARPS container at Yucaipa City Hall while supplies last or residents can safely dispose of their used SHARPS in a plastic container up to 1 gallon in size.

#### <u>Container Use</u>

- 1. Deposit syringes, needles and lancets into SHARPS container with the sharp end first.
- 2. After container is full, snap the cap firmly to close and seal securely.
- 3. Do not fill the container to the top.

### Proper Disposal of Container

Dispose of SHARPS containers into the SHARPS Drop-Off box located at Yucaipa Police Department at 34144 Yucaipa Blvd., Yucaipa CA.



#### Sharps Drop-Off Box

#### HOW TO CREATE YOUR OWN SHARPS CONTAINER:

- Place sharps into a rigid plastic container up to 1 gallon in size
- Do not use food product containers
- Must have a screw-top and puncture resistant lid
- Made of thick plastic
- Leak-resistant
- Remain upright when standing
- Write "Bio-Hazard SHARPS" on both sides of container using a permanent marker
- When filled, secure lid, and tape the container closed

All unwanted materials can be placed directly into the container with the exception of hazardous waste, tires or large amounts of dirt, rock, concrete, or asphalt. ### **Bulky Item Pick-Up**

Are you replacing an old sofa, water heater or refrigerator and don't know what to do with it? We'll take care of it. Residents can request up to four curbside collections of large or bulky items during a 12 month period (pick-up second week of Feb/May/Aug/Nov). Limit of five items per collection. This program also includes electronic waste. This program is at no additional cost and designed for your convenience. Please call our Customer Service Department one week prior to your scheduled collection day to arrange pick-up.

## City of Yucaipa Street Sweeping Program

Yucaipa Disposal provides street sweeping services in order to assist the City of Yucaipa in maintaining clean streets and improving the environment. Arterial streets are swept twice a month while residential streets are swept once per month. Please see the current street sweeping schedule map to identify the street sweeping day in your neighborhood. A copy of the street sweeping schedule map is also available on the City of Yucaipa website: yucaipa.org/street-sweeping/

Remember to move vehicles parked at the curb on your street sweeping day. It is also important to remind any service providers at your home or business (gardener, pool cleaner, etc.) of the street sweeping schedule and that their vehicle should not be parked on the street in order to allow access to curb and gutter. Street sweeping services are provided at no additional cost.
