Community Clean-Up Day Activities

Rialto Residents Only (Proof of Residency Required)

October 26, 2024 • 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Document Shredding (150 S. Palm Ave) – Protect your identity. Shred your personal documents for free. The shredding truck will be on site from **8 a.m. to 2 p.m.** or until the truck is full.

Electronic Waste (150 S. Palm Ave) – Bring your televisions, microwaves, computers, monitors and other electronics.

Usable Items (150 S. Palm Ave) – The Salvation Army will be accepting usable household items such as clean clothing, shoes, furniture, sports equipment, etc.

Free Trash Disposal (150 S. Palm Ave) – Rialto residents can now dispose of trash, bulky items, and green waste for free. Bring furniture, mattresses, scrap metal, toilets, wood/branches, yard trimmings etc.

Used Tires (335 W. Rialto Ave) – Rialto residents can bring up to 9 used tires for free disposal. We will not accept tires from businesses, including semi-trucks.

Household Hazardous Waste (246 S. Willow) – Rialto's Household Hazardous Waste Site will accept your used motor oil and filters, paint, household cleaners, pesticides, weed killers, batteries, syringes, fluorescent bulbs, medications and other household chemicals. **We cannot accept explosives, medical waste, abandoned waste, or business waste.** *This site is free to all residents of San Bernardino County.*

Windy Day Advisory

Weather conditions cause problems with the collection of trash and recyclables. Containers frequently tip over, causing spillage and materials to get strewn throughout streets and neighborhoods. In an effort to assist in the prevention of these situations, the following are suggestions:

- Bag and tie trash and/or recyclables before placing in barrels – This will make clean-up efforts easier should the barrels blow over.
- Avoid placing trash and/or recycling out on windy days – If possible, do not set your trash or recyclables out for collection on windy days. Bag any excessive trash and recyclables that will not fit in your barrel and Burrtec will collect all accumulated bags along with your containers on your next scheduled collection day.

Appliance Bulky Item Pick Up IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The proper way to dispose of refrigerators and certain appliances involves either taping the door shut or completely removing the door or the latching mechanism before placing the bulky item out for pick up.

Before disposing of large appliances, tape doors or remove doors and/or hinges on all large appliances to prevent entrance and entrapment by small children.



Temporary Containers for Special Clean-Ups Available



Burrtec offers large and small containers for residential clean-ups and special projects. Containers are available for seven-day rentals and include delivery and removal. All unwanted materials can be placed directly into the container with the exception of hazardous waste, tires or large amounts of dirt, rock, concrete or asphalt. Rialto Household Hazardous Waste Site

246 S. Willow Ave., Rialto (Behind the City's Maintenance Office)

The HHW collection site will be open from 8 a.m. to 12 noon on the following dates:

- **October 11, 12, 25, 26**
- **November 8, 9, 22, 23**
- **December 6, 7, 20, 21**

The site accepts paint, pool chemicals, used motor oil and filters, household cleaners, fertilizers, old medications, pesticides, fluorescent lights, syringes, and batteries. The site cannot accept business waste, explosives, or medical waste.

The site provides **free containers** for used oil, and drained, used oil filters. Just ask the site staff.
