### **Community Clean-Up Day Activities**

Rialto Residents Only (Proof of Residency Required)
October 25, 2025 • 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

**Document Shredding (150 S. Palm Ave)** – Protect your identity. Shred your personal documents for free. The shredding truck will be on site from **8 a.m. to 2 p.m.** or until the truck is full.

Electronic Waste (150 S. Palm Ave) – Bring your televisions, microwaves, computers, monitors and other electronics.

**Usable Items (150 S. Palm Ave)** – The Salvation Army will be accepting usable household items such as clean clothing, shoes, furniture, sports equipment, etc.

**Free Trash Disposal (150 S. Palm Ave)** – Rialto residents can now dispose of trash, bulky items, and green waste for free. Bring furniture, mattresses, scrap metal, toilets, wood/branches, yard trimmings etc.

**Used Tires (335 W. Rialto Ave)** – Rialto residents can bring up to 9 used tires for free disposal. We <u>will not</u> accept tires from businesses, including semi-trucks.

Household Hazardous Waste (246 S. Willow) – Rialto's Household Hazardous Waste Site will accept your used motor oil and filters, paint, household cleaners, pesticides, weed killers, batteries, syringes, fluorescent bulbs, medications and other household chemicals. We cannot accept explosives, medical waste, abandoned waste, or business waste. This site is free to all residents of San Bernardino County.

### **Windy Day Advisory**

Weather conditions can make trash and recycling collection challenging. Containers often tip over, spilling materials that end up scattered across streets and neighborhoods. To help prevent this, here are some suggestions:

- Bag and tie trash and/or recyclables before placing in barrels This will make clean-up efforts easier should the barrels blow over.
- Consider holding your barrels until your next collection day if they are not full. If possible, wait to set out trash or recyclables on extremely windy days. For any extra bags that won't fit in your barrels, place them out on your next collection day Burrtec will collect them along with your containers.



# The Holidays are Soon Approaching

Burrtec will collect and recycle Christmas trees from single-family residences. Please place your tree at curbside after Christmas on your collection day. Burrtec will provide this service for approximately 2 weeks after Christmas Day. Trees 6' and over need to be cut in half. Please take all ornaments, lights, and metal stands off of the tree. Flocked and Non-Flocked trees will be collected and recycled.

#### **Extra Holiday Waste**

Approximately 80% of your holiday trash is recyclable. Gift boxes, wrapping paper, greeting cards, and cardboard packaging may all be placed in your recycling barrel. Burrtec will collect your excess holiday trash and recyclables for approximately 1 week following the day after Christmas. You may place excess holiday trash/recyclables in bags alongside your containers on your scheduled collection day.



#### Rialto Household Hazardous Waste Site

246 S. Willow Ave., Rialto (Behind the City's Maintenance Office)

The HHW collection site will be open from 8 a.m. to 12 noon on the following dates:

- October 10, 11, 24, 25
- November 7, 8, 21, 22
- December 5, 6, 19, 20

The site accepts paint, pool chemicals, used motor oil and filters, household cleaners, fertilizers, old medications, pesticides, fluorescent lights, syringes, and batteries. The site cannot accept business waste, explosives, or medical waste.

The site provides free containers for used oil, and drained, used oil filters. Just ask the site staff.
