Extra Holiday Waste

Approximately 80% of holiday trash is recyclable. All gift boxes, wrapping paper, greeting cards, and cardboard packaging are items that may be placed in the recycling barrel. Burrtec will collect excess holiday trash and recyclables for a 1 week period after Christmas Day. Single-family residences may place excess holiday trash/recyclables in bags alongside their containers on collection day.

Christmas Tree Recycling

Burrtec will collect and recycle Christmas trees from single-family residences. Please place your tree at curbside after Christmas on your collection day. Burrtec will provide this service for an approximately 2 week period after Christmas Day. Trees 6' and over need to be cut in half. Please take all ornaments, lights, and metal stands off of the tree. Flocked and Non-Flocked trees will be collected and recycled.



Sustainability Update

FOOD WASTE Recycling Program and YOU!

The California Senate passed a bill to improve air quality and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. CalRecycle reports that landfilled organic waste (including food waste) decomposes in landfills and generates greenhouse gases contributing to global climate change. Starting in 2022, all California residents will be required to participate in a Food Waste Recycling Program in order to comply with Senate Bill 1383.

The City of Rialto has applied for a revised implementation timeline. Compliance with this program will prevent the City of Rialto from receiving significant fines and penalties of up to \$10,000 per day.

The food waste recycling program is scheduled to start in July, 2023. More detailed information will be available as the program nears. Stay tuned for more information!

Holiday Schedule

Please note that services are interrupted on the following holidays:

*Due to the 2022 Christmas and 2023 New Year's Day holidays on Sunday. there will be no service interruptions or delays during the holiday weeks.



When the holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. There is no service interruption or delay when the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday.



Collection Day Reminder

On collection day, please place your containers in the street, at the curb, or near the corner of your driveway. Handles of your containers should be facing your home. Containers should be placed 1 foot apart from each other. The containers need to be placed at least 3 feet away from any obstruction such as a fence, mailbox, or vehicle.

All containers must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your ser vice day.

Pest Control

Weather & Windy Days

Weather conditions cause problems with the collection of trash and recyclables. Containers frequently tip over, causing spillage and materials to be strewn throughout streets and neighborhoods. In an effort to assist in the prevention of these situations please:

- Bag and tie trash and/or recyclables before placing in barrels – This will make clean-up efforts easier should the barrels blow over.
- Avoid placing trash and/or recycling out on windy days

 If possible; do not set your trash or recyclables out for collection on windy days. Bag any excess trash and recyclables that will not fit in your barrel and Burrtec will collect all accumulated bags along with your containers on your next scheduled collection day.

Bulky Item Pick-Up

Are you replacing an old sofa, water heater or refrigerator and don't know what to do with it? We'll take care of it. Residents can request up to two curbside collections of large or bulky items during a calendar year. Limit of ten items per collection. This program also includes electronic waste. This program is at no additional cost and designed for your convenience. Please call our Customer Service Department one week prior to your scheduled collection day to arrange pick-up.



Temporary Containers for Special Clean-Ups Available



Burrtec offers large and small containers for residential clean-ups and special projects. Containers are available for 7-day rentals and include delivery and removal. All unwanted materials can be placed directly into the container with the exception of hazardous waste, tires or large amounts of dirt, rock, concrete, or asphalt. The HHW collection site will be open from 8am to 12 noon on the following dates:

- January 13, 14, 27, 28
- February 10, 11, 24, 25
- March 10, 11, 24, 25

We accept paint, pool chemicals, used motor oil and filters, household cleaners, fertilizers, old medications, pesticides, fluorescent lights, syringes, and batteries. We can not accept business waste, explosives, or medical waste.

We provide **free containers** for sharps collection, containers for used oil, and oil filter buckets. Just ask at the site.
