#### Free Bulky Item Collection

Santa Clarita residents receive up to four (4) free bulky item pick-ups per year, with no limit on items per pick-up. Please contact Burrtec Customer Service at (661) 222-2249 at least 48 hours in advance of your regular service day to schedule a bulky item pick-up.

**Acceptable items include:** furniture, appliances and mattresses. For the health and safety of our drivers, we ask that all mattresses be wrapped in plastic.

**Non-acceptable items include:** hazardous waste, machinery and industrial discards, oil, grease and other liquids, construction and demolition debris or excessively large items.

## Did You Know?

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) includes items like paint, pesticides and electronic waste. There are many other household items that may seem non-toxic but are very harmful to the environment if not disposed of properly. Items like pool chemicals, household cleaners, automotive fluids, medication and needles, beauty products, batteries and compact fluorescent light bulbs are all considered HHW items.

For FREE and convenient disposal of these items, the City of Santa Clarita has partnered with the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works and the Sanitation Districts of Los Angeles County to offer residents an **HHW Collection event on Saturday, April 15, 2023 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at College of the Canyons (26455 Rockwell Canyon Rd)**. These events throughout the year are a great opportunity to drop-off unwanted household chemicals, electronic waste, and lancets/sharps (needles).

## Collection Day Reminder

On collection day, please place your trash, green waste and recycling carts in the street, at the curb, or near the corner of your driveway. **DO NOT place carts on the curb or sidewalk.** Carts should have the handles facing towards your home and placed 1 foot apart from each other. Carts need to be placed at least 3 feet away from any obstruction such as a fence, mailbox, or vehicle. **All carts must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your service day.**

## Sustainability Update

The food waste recycling program begins July 1, 2023 in your area!

The California Senate passed a bill to **improve air quality and reduce greenhouse gas emissions**. CalRecycle reports that landfilled organic waste (including food waste) decomposes in landfills and generates greenhouse gases contributing to global climate change. Starting in 2022, all California residents may be required to participate in a Food Waste Recycling Program in order to comply with **Senate Bill 1383**.



SCAN TO LEARN MORE

Senate Bill 1383 requires a **75% reduction in organic waste disposal statewide by 2025**.

All residences and commercial businesses may be required to participate in this program to **recycle organic waste, including food waste**.
