Collection Day Reminder

On collection day, please place your garbage, organics and recycling carts in the street, at the curb, or near the corner of your driveway. **DO NOT place carts on the curb or sidewalk.** Carts should have the handles facing towards your home and placed 1 foot apart from each other. Carts need to be placed at least 3 feet away from any obstruction such as a fence, mailbox or vehicle. **To ensure your service is not missed, all carts must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your service day.**



Windy Day Advisory

Windy weather can cause problems with the collection of waste, tipping containers and allowing for waste to litter streets and neighborhoods. To prevent littering caused by wind:

- Bag and tie trash before placing in carts This will make clean-up efforts easier should the carts blow over.
- Avoid placing trash and/or recycling out on windy days Bag any excessive trash and recyclables that will not fit in your cart and Burrtec will collect all accumulated bags along with your containers on your next scheduled collection day.

ORGANICS RECYCLING

Reminder: California passed Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) to reduce the amount of organic waste disposal in landfills. All residents and commercial businesses are required to recycle organic waste, including food waste.

Organic waste decomposing in landfills releases methane, a greenhouse gas that contributes to public health and safety concerns such as asthma, extreme weather, natural disasters and climate change. Recycling organic waste, instead of sending it to a landfill, helps close the sustainability loop by creating a nutrient-rich soil amendment ready for use at farms and in gardens.

TIPS TO PREVENT FOOD WASTE AT HOME

- **Plan ahead:** Before going to the grocery store to purchase more, check the fridge and pantry to make sure you are using items before they expire.
- Serve smart: Aim to cook and serve the right portions for the number of people you are feeding.
- Store food wisely: Store food and ingredients in proper containers and under the right conditions.
- Check your fridge often: Keep track of what you have and what needs to be used first. Eat or freeze
 items before they spoil.
- Use your freezer: Storing some items in the freezer will keep food fresher longer and save you money.
