Shredding Limit:
Four (4) standard-size boxes only.

Accepted Bulky Items: Appliances, Metals, BBQs, Mattresses, Furniture, Rugs, Tires, 4 standard size boxes of paper

Not Accepted: Household Hazardous, Waste, Dirt, Rock, Construction Waste, Loose Items, Binders, CDs/DVDs

Free Recycled Christmas Tree Mulch

Last January, Burrtec recycled more than 500 tons of Christmas trees through their Material Recovery Facility (MRF), transforming your Christmas tree into nutrient-rich mulch. Christmas tree recycling is continuing again this year, turning Christmas trees into something that will keep giving in the new year.

The City of Upland uses recycled Christmas tree mulch for landscaping projects around the City. Mulch has numerous benefits, such as helping to prevent weeds from sprouting and conserving soil moisture.

Free recycled Christmas tree mulch is available to Upland residents through the end of January, on a first-come, first-served basis, while supplies last. New stock is replenished daily. Recycled Christmas tree mulch is available for pick up at Burrtec's West Valley Transfer Station/MRF, Monday – Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; and Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Call (909) 899-0911 for more information.

How to Recycle Your Christmas Tree

- Remove all ornaments, tinsel, lights, and other decorations.
- Trees six feet tall and over must be cut in half.
- Place tree at curbside after Christmas on your collection day. Burrtec will provide this service for approximately a 2-week period after Christmas Day.

Burrtec will collect flocked and non-flocked trees for recycling. For artificial trees, contact Burrtec Customer Service at (909) 949-0500 to schedule a bulky item pick-up.

City of Upland Street Sweeping Program

Burrtec provides street sweeping services through CMAX in order to assist the City of Upland in maintaining clean streets and improving the environment. Residential streets are swept twice per month. Please see the current street sweeping schedule map below to identify the street sweeping day in your neighborhood. Remember to move vehicles parked at the curb on your street sweeping day so a thorough cleaning can be achieved. It is also important to remind any service providers at your home or business (gardener, pool cleaner, etc.) of the street sweeping schedule and that their vehicle should not be parked on the street in order to allow access to curb and gutter.
