Holiday Tree Collection

Burrtec will pick up and recycle your Christmas tree. Please place it at the curb on your regular collection day, starting after Christmas. This service will be available for about two weeks following the holiday.

- Make sure your tree stand is removed, as well as all lights, ornaments, tinsel and other decorations.
- Do not place them inside or on top of any barrel.
- Do not block sidewalks, driveways, cars or mailboxes.
- Please cut large trees (over 6 feet) in half.
- Artificial trees are not accepted.
- We will accept trees with flocking decoration.

Thank you for your help in getting your trees composted properly.

Burrtec's Material Recovery Facilities (MRF) offer Christmas tree mulch at NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE. The Christmas tree mulch is provided on a first come, first serve basis. Mulch is available while supplies last. New stock is replenished daily. Other landscape products such as compost, mulch and wood chips are also available for purchase.

When the holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. There is no service interruption or delay when the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday.

City of Upland Street Sweeping Program

Burrtec provides street sweeping services through CMAX Sanitary Services in order to assist the City of Upland in maintaining clean streets and improving the environment. Residential streets are swept twice per month. Please see the current street sweeping schedule map to identify the street sweeping day in your neighborhood. A copy of the street sweeping schedule map is available on the City of Upland's website: https://www.uplandca.gov/street-sweeping

On street sweeping day, please remember to move all vehicles parked on the street to allow the sweeper access to the curb and gutters. Please ensure the street is clear of obstructions, such as basketball hoops, vehicles, and low hanging tree branches. It is also important to inform any service providers at your home or business (such as gardeners or pool cleaners) about the street sweeping schedule and remind them not to park on the street.

TIPS TO PREVENT FOOD WASTE AT HOME

- Plan ahead: Before you go to the grocery store or order out, check the fridge and pantry for food items that need to be cooked or that you already have and do not need to purchase.
- Serve smart: Aim to cook and serve the right portions for the number of people you are feeding.
- Store food wisely: Different foods require different conditions.
- Check your fridge often: Keep track of what you have and what needs to be used. Eat or freeze items before you need to throw them away.
- Use your freezer: Your freezer can help save food and time.

Your recycling efforts contribute to the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions from landfilled organic waste. This includes methane, a greenhouse gas 80 times more potent than carbon dioxide.
