- This is a self serve event, please bring your own sturdy bags, pails, containers, trucks and/or trailers and gloves to load the compost/mulch.

Bulky Item Pick-Up

Are you replacing an old sofa, water heater or refrigerator and don't know what to do with it? We'll take care of it. Residents can request up to four curbside collections of large or bulky items during a 12 month period (pick-up second week of Feb/May/Aug/Nov). Limit of five items per collection. This program also includes electronic waste. This program is at no additional cost and designed for your convenience. Please call our Customer Service Department one week prior to your scheduled collection day to arrange pick-up.



Electronic Waste (E-waste)

Electronic waste may contain potentially toxic substances such as lead, copper, and other heavy metals. This is why they must be disposed of properly! Electronic waste, or e-waste, may include computers, monitors and televisions. Residents may place up to two e-waste items out with their bulky items for pickup. Please do not place e-waste in any of the barrels. Please Contact our Customer Service Department for more information.



Holiday Schedule



Please note that services are interrupted on the following holidays:

When the holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. There is no service interruption or delay when the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday.

The Holidays Are Soon Approaching



Yucaipa Disposal will collect and recycle Christmas trees from single-family residences. Please place your tree at the curbside on your collection day after Christmas. Services will be available for approximately two weeks following Christmas Day. Please ensure that all ornaments, lights, and metal stands are removed from the tree. Trees that are six feet tall or taller must be cut in half. Flocked trees will not be recycled and will be collected as trash.

Extra Holiday Waste

Yucaipa Disposal will collect your excess holiday trash and recyclables for approximately one week following the day after Christmas. You may place excess holiday trash/recyclables in bags alongside your containers on your scheduled collection day.



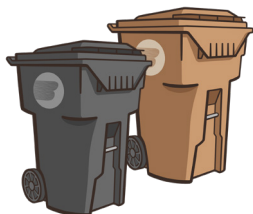
How to Recycle Food Waste at Home

- Collect-** Begin collecting food waste separate from your trash and recycling. This includes: fruits, vegetables, meats, seafood, bread, dairy, eggshells, coffee, plate scrapings, peels, rinds, and food soiled paper such as napkins and coffee filters.
- Add & Secure-** Collect food waste & food soiled paper in its own separate plastic bag. Store it in a convenient place, such as on your counter top, in your refrigerator or under your sink. Secure plastic bag by tying it off. Remember bags do not have to be compostable or biodegradable. They can be any color. We encourage you to re-use bags you may already have such as bread bags and produce bags.
- Discard-** Place your bagged food waste & food soiled paper into your green barrel. Continue using your green waste barrel for non-bagged landscape waste. Remember, food waste no longer belongs in your trash barrel.
