Where: Yucaipa Community Center West parking lot (34900 Oak Glen Rd.)

Date: Saturday, May 11, 2024 **Time:** 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Shred Event Details:

Please bring proof of residency such as driver's license or identification.

Free confidential on-site document shredding. (Yucaipa residents ONLY) ****shred event ends at 12:00 p.m. or when truck is full.***

What to bring:

- Residents may bring up to 4 boxes (banker box size, 12" x 10" x 16") or 4 bags no larger than 15-gallons per person.
- Please only bring paper that should be shredded (most junk mail does not need to be shredded). Magazines, phone books, catalogs, etc. will not be accepted.
- Walk ups are not allowed. For your safety and to ensure everyone is treated fairly, please drive through the line and do not get out of your car. Staff will unload your materials and take them to the onsite shredder.
- There is no cost to residents for this service.

Compost Giveaway Details:

- Free to Yucaipa residents, while supply lasts!
- This is a self serve event so please bring sturdy bags, pails, containers, gloves and a shovel to take and load your compost. First come, first serve.
- Please bring proof of residency such as driver's license or identification.

- Helps retain moisture to reduce watering
- Controls erosion
- Suppresses weed growth
- Provides beneficial nutrients to improve soil

Horse Manure Disposal

Manure must be hauled away weekly in proper containers. Burrtec offers Yucaipa residents manure recycling pickup services. Call Burrtec Customer Service for more information.

Reminder: Green waste bins are for green waste only. Do not mix manure into those containers.



Collection Day Reminder

On collection day, please place your containers in the street, at the curb, or near the corner of your driveway. The containers handles should be facing your home. Barrels should be placed 1 foot apart from each other. The containers need to be placed at least 3 feet away from any obstruction such as a fence, mailbox, or vehicle.

All barrels must be curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your service day.



Electronic Waste (E-waste)

Electronic waste may contain potentially toxic substances such as lead, copper, and other heavy metals. This is why they must be disposed of properly! Electronic waste, or e-waste, may include computers, monitors and televisions. Residents may place up to two e-waste items out with their bulky items for pickup. Please do not place e-waste in any of the barrels. Please Contact our Customer Service Department for more information.
