Christmas Tree Recycling

Yucaipa Disposal will collect and recycle Christmas trees from single-family residences. Please place your tree at curbside after Christmas on your collection day. Yucaipa Disposal will provide this service for approximately a 2 week period after Christmas Day. Trees 6 feet and over need to be cut in half. Please take all ornaments, lights, and metal stands off of the tree. Flocked trees will not be recycled. They will be collected as trash.

Extra Holiday Waste

The holidays are approaching! Yucaipa Disposal will collect your excess holiday trash. Beginning the day after Christmas for approximately 1 week, place excess holiday trash in bags alongside your container(s)on your collection day.

Food Waste Recycling Is here!

California passed a law to improve air quality and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The state reports that landfilled organic waste (including food waste) decomposes in landfills and generates greenhouse gases contributing to global climate change.

Food waste no longer goes into your black trash barrel. Residents can now start recycling their food waste by placing it in a clear bag in the green organics barrel.

REMEMBER: If you see a scavenger, do not approach them! Get a description of the person and/or vehicle with license plate number and their direction of travel.

When the holiday falls on a weekday, collections for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. There is no service interruption or delay when the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday.

Bulky Item Pick-Up

Are you replacing an old sofa, water heater or refrigerator and don't know what to do with it? We'll take care of it. Residents can request up to four curbside collections of large or bulky items during a 12 month period (pick-up second week of Feb/May/Aug/Nov). Limit of five items per collection. This program also includes electronic waste. This program is at no additional cost and designed for your convenience. Please call our Customer Service Department one week prior to your scheduled collection day to arrange pick-up.
