MANDATORY ORGANICS LEGISLATION

The California State Legislature approved Assembly Bill 1826 (AB 1826) which sets forth statewide mandatory commercial organic waste recycling. The requirements to comply were recently adjusted to include all businesses generating 2 cubic yards or more of solid waste per week and multifamily customers with 5 units or more that generate 2 cubic yards of solid waste per week must arrange for organic recycling services. Organic waste is food waste, landscape and pruning waste, and

nonhazardous wood waste.



The State requires that applicable business generators:

- Separate organic waste from other waste and participate in a waste recycling service that includes collection and recycling of organic waste, or:
- Recycle its organic waste on site, or self-haul its organic waste off-site for recycling, or:
- Donate edible food waste to an eligible food rescue organization.

Please note: businesses should check with the City of Rancho Cucamonga for self-haul and on site recycling requirements.

MANDATORY SOLID WASTE SERVICE & PAYMENT

Solid waste collection service and payment for solid waste collection service is mandatory for every occupied residential, commercial and industrial property per the Rancho Cucamonga Municipal Code. Solid waste accounts that are 60 or more days past due shall constitute a lien against the property for which the solid waste collection services were provided and shall include the delinquent amount plus administrative fees.

MANDATED RECYCLING

One outstanding feature of Burrtec's commitment to the City of Rancho Cucamonga is recycling collection at no additional charge.
