**Subject: CHANGES-NEW TRASH AND RECYCLING CARTS**

We are excited to announce that the **NEW** Residential Organics Recycling Program is here. Starting in the first week of November, Burrtec will distribute updated equipment to Rancho Mirage residents as required to meet state-mandated SB-1383.

As part of this program, you will receive a new blue recycling cart, a green cart for organics, a kitchen pail for food scraps, and your current gray cart will be converted to trash. Included in this notice are “Take Me” stickers; please use these if you want Burrtec to take your old trash bins. Upon delivery of your new carts, if you choose to keep your old trash bins, they must be stored separately, as they are no longer usable for trash services. **PLEASE BEGIN TO USE YOUR NEW CARTS UPON RECEIPT**

The Kitchen Food Scrap Pail, to be provided to all households, is a convenient way to collect and bag food scraps in your kitchen before disposing of the food scraps bag in the outside green organics cart. **BE SURE TO LOOK INSIDE** your kitchen pail as residents will receive an introductory set of pail liners and instructional materials, and... 400 randomly selected households will receive a **\$10 gift card** to a Rancho Mirage Business.
